Please note the following guidelines and schedules.

Student's Rights:

A student has the right to.....

- ✓ Be respected and not be physically or emotionally abused.
- ✓ Express their ideas when appropriate.
- ✓ Be an individual at school, free from prejudice and discrimination.
- ✓ Receive knowledge in accordance to their academic school level.

School Rules and Regulations.

Students must follow these rules:

- ✓ Be on time for school.
- ✓ Wear proper school uniform.
- ✓ Keep your overall appearance suitable for school.
- ✓ Behave respectfully to adults and fellow students.
- ✓ Mental or physical actions are NOT accepted under any circumstances.
- ✓ You must converse in English at all times.
- ✓ Complete any given assessment on time.
- ✓ Bring proper materials and writing tools.
- ✓ Be responsible for your things.
- ✓ Keep the school premises clean.
- ✓ Do not leave school without the permission of the administration.
- ✓ Assigning students to their classes refers to the school authority only. Parents are not permitted to choose their kids' classes under any circumstances.
- ✓ School official sites and apps. are the only means of communication with the school staff.

Not Allowed:

The following are not allowed:

- ✓ The use of mobiles on campus during the school day.
- ✓ Cameras, video cams, and games in the classroom.
- ✓ Eating and gum chewing during classes.
- ✓ Littering.
- ✓ Converse in Arabic at school.

Behavior that is contrary to the above will lead to disciplinary consequences. All faculty members have the authority to uphold school rules.

• **Students' Attendance Policy:**

- School hours will be announced via text messages. While on school premises and during these hours the students are the school's responsibility and are therefore not allowed to leave without the permission from the administration office. This responsibility ends at 2:00 p.m.
- ✓ If late to school, a student must check in with the administration to receive an entry slip.
- ✓ Any Absence must be verified by the parent or guardian with a written excuse presented to the office. The only acceptable excuse for absence is illness or an emergency. Absences three day or more require a medical excuse.

• **Student Dress Code**

- ✓ School uniform is compulsory for all students.
- ✓ Students may receive a warning, if they do not wear the uniform.
- ✓ No colored shirts or T-shirts.
- ✓ No necklaces, bracelets or rings. Only plain ear studs are permitted. These will be confiscated for a period of time.
- ✓ No makeup is permitted.
- ✓ No high heels.
- ✓ No nail polish.

- **Classroom Rules:**

These rules **must be** followed by all students:

- ✓ I must converse in English at all times. English is the tongue of our school.
- ✓ I must pay attention and listen carefully to the teacher.
- ✓ I must raise my hand and ask for permission to talk.
- ✓ I must not talk unless the teacher asks me to.
- ✓ I must always take good care of my books and things.
- ✓ I must make sure that I take all my belongings before I leave the school.
- ✓ I must be honest and sincere.
- ✓ I must never hurt anyone.
- ✓ I must be considerate to others.
- ✓ Leave class during a period only if carrying a permit card.

- **Mobile Rules:**

- ✓ Bring your mobile phone to the school **when required** as it will be kept with the administration at the beginning of the day and receive them **after** school hours. Any misuse of the mobile phone may result in **permanent** confiscation.
- ✓ Use the school phone for **emergency** calls **only**.
- ✓ In case the mobile is found with the students, the administrations will confiscate it for the first time and ask the parents to come to school and pick it up by the end of the week. In case the mobile is found for the second time, it will be confiscated till the end of the school year.

Students need to be aware of the following:

- ✓ Students will sign promissory notes after violating any of school's rules and regulations (the signing of three promissory notes will result in **expulsion**)
- ✓ A promissory note is to be signed after an oral warning.
